

## **2010 Wright County Fair Queen**

Queen candidates are being sought for the 2010 Wright County Fair July 7<sup>th</sup> to the 12<sup>th</sup>. Contestants must be at least 16 years of age and no more than 21 on the first day of the Iowa State Fair, August 12<sup>th</sup>. Contestants must have never been married nor had a child. The queen and princess are to attend all fair events and hand out ribbons for each show.

The Queen receives a Jewelry Armoires and an expense paid trip to the Iowa State Fair Queen competition, August 10<sup>th</sup> through August 14<sup>th</sup>.

Judging for the Wright County Fair Queen competition will be held at First Lutheran Church in Clarion on 4:00 PM in the afternoon on Wednesday, June 23<sup>rd</sup>. Candidates will have an individual interview with three judges. Judging is based on personality, attitude, appearance and leadership. You do not have to be a 4-H member.

For the individual interview, clothing that would be worn to a job interview would be appropriate. Candidates will then change into casual outfit for a light lunch with the judges; finally the candidates will change into an evening dress (prom dress) for final judging. Family members are encouraged to attend and give the girls an audience.

All candidates will ride in the fair parade on Wednesday, July 7<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 PM. The evening will conclude with the Queen and Princess being announced following the 4-H Fashion Review and Share the Fun on the Free Stage of the Wright County Fair.
